

St Peter's School Assessment Data - July 2018

Please see below the results of teacher assessments for EYFS (Reception), the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check test, teacher assessments for Year 2 and national test results for Year 6 in July 2018. Our results are significantly above the National figures and at KS2 they are even higher than last year's school results (see below). The figures in brackets are the results for 2017 (and may not total 100 due to rounding).
