An At Home Family Retreat for





LECTIO DIVINA (HOLY READING)

Read the text, out loud if you are able, then read it though again in silence, 2 or 3 times. "Chew over" the words in your mind, allowing yourself to sit with them. Perhaps a particular word, or phrase, will strike you, but don't worry if it doesn't. Read the text aloud again, "chew over", or allow the words to wash over you, for another while. A prayer or a thought may come to you which you can carry with you through the day. End with the Our Father and the Sign of the Cross.

If you are keeping a Holy Week Journal, the suggestions below may be helpful.


It was almost time for the Jewish Feast of Passover. The leading priests and teachers of the law were trying to find a way to kill Jesus. But they were afraid of the people.



This is Holy Week – Good Friday

When Jesus was in the garden praying, Judas entered with the soldiers. They arrested Jesus and took him to the High Priest's house. The High Priest and Temple leaders wanted to put Jesus to death because he had said that God was his Father. But they needed permission from the Romans.

So the soldiers led Jesus to the Roman Governor, Pontius Pilate. But Pilate could not find any fault with Jesus. Instead he had him flogged, the soldiers placed a crown of thorns on his head and they mocked him.


But the crowd persisted, shouting at Pilate, "Crucify him". Finally, Pilate gave in. Bloodied and tired, Jesus took up the heavy wooden cross and carried it to a hill called Golgotha. Here, soldiers nailed Jesus' hands and feet to the cross.

As Jesus hung there, he prayed to God, "Father, forgive them. They do not know what they are doing." Later that afternoon, Jesus cried out, "It is finished." He hung his head and died.

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This is Holy Week – Holy Saturday

The next day Pilate ordered his soldiers to guard the tomb for three days. Some of those who had wanted Jesus killed were worried that the disciples would secretly steal Jesus's body and pretend that he was alive.

This was because they remembered that Jesus had said, "After three days I will rise again."
