

Maths: In Maths lessons, Year 3 children will be taught the following topics:

- Fractions
- Time
- Angles and properties of shape
- Mass and capacity

We will continue to revise and revisit the four main operations throughout this term (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

Children will continue to learn their times tables accessing Times Tables Rock Stars.

English: This term, children will be developing their reading and writing (including punctuation, spelling and grammar) which are sometime linked to our guided reading texts and topics.

Will we revisit all of the punctuation we have learnt about this year so that we are confident to use it within a range of writing genres.

The punctuation covered in Year 3 can be seen in the box to the right.

Spellings: We will continue to learn the spelling rules allocated to the Year 3, as well learning some of the Year 3 and 4 words.

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Art and Design: Children will continue to improve their mastery of art and design techniques including drawing, painting and sculpture including, making an Ancient Greek pot. We will be looking at various artists and using their work for inspiration.

Reading: This term we will be reading, 'Danny the Champion of the World' by Roald Dahl.

We will mainly be focusing on vocabulary and inference skills whilst linking this to our English work.

Science:

During this term, the Year 3 topics are:

- **Rocks and Fossils (Part 2)**
- **Plants and living things.**

We encourage all children in Year 3 to continue to do their own research for these topics at home, which they can show their class during show and tell sessions.



Computing: Children will be using technology for a range of tasks, including researching information about Ancient Greece and our world. We will revisit how to keep safe on the internet as well as developing our skills using our chrome books.

Throughout this term, we will continue to use goggle classroom in some of our lessons within our school day.

RE: In our RE lessons, we will continue to follow the, 'Come and See' programme of study. The topics covered are; 'Energy, Choices and Special Places'. Our other faith studied will be Islam.

P.E:

Our PE days are **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**.

Skill Focus: balls skills, athletics & striking and fielding

Children will be continuing to change within the school day, going home in their PE Kit.

History: Ancient Greece

We will be carrying out a study into Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.

We will also be examining the legacy of Greek culture on later periods of British history including the present day (e.g. The Olympic Games).

Geography: Wonderful World

In this topic, we will be developing our knowledge of some of the most significant physical geographic features.

We will be carrying out an in-depth study into a climate zone, biome and vegetation belts and presenting our findings in different ways.

Reading: Children should continue to read out aloud at home every day. Please ask your children questions about what they have read to check their understanding.
