# GEOGRAPHY

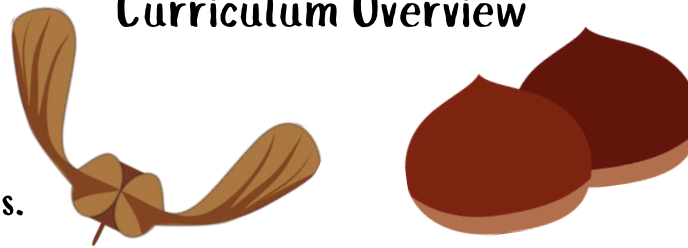
