From Sunday's Gospel...

This Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Easter. In this week's Gospel, (John10:27-30) Jesus uses the metaphors of sheep and shepherds to describe his relationship with his followers. Jesus also describes his relationship with the Father, saying that they

are one. This means that to know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. 

There will be four photographs selected as winners.



Sadly, we have been made aware of two serious issues around parking and traffic around our school. We understand that, although our site is tricky to access, most parents drive and park considerately and carefully, but the events we are hearing about regarding the behaviour of some parents at the start and end of the school day are beginning to damage our reputation with our local community and must be addressed.

A near miss on our school drive

Last week one of our Y3 children was involved in a very scary near miss. While they were walking down the driveway into school with their parent, a car approached the school gates. The car then reversed and narrowly missed hitting the child who had to jump out of the way. The main concern about this incident was that the car driver appeared unaware of what had happened which highlights the dangers of moving cars sharing space with small children who can easily be in a blind spot.

Our driveway is very busy with pedestrians in the morning and afternoon and parents should not use it (or Kingfisher Drive) as a 'drop off' location. This incident was a near-miss but the next time may not be...

Anti- Social behaviour/ Inconsiderate Parking

We have been informed by the residents of Linden Gardens that residents are experiencing issues leaving their properties due to the way that some parents have parked. **Blocking a driveway and preventing someone from getting their own vehicle out, could be deemed as antisocial behaviour and can be reported to the police.** We have advised residents who experience this issue to use the Surrey Police online reporting tool. https://www.surrey.police.uk/ro/report/asb/asb/report-antisocial-behaviour/

Dangerous Parking

If a vehicle is parked:

- on zig zag lines,
- dangerously, or
- in a way that would prevent emergency vehicles from accessing

then this needs to be reported to Surrey Police as a **crime**. We urge all members of our community to work together to safeguard against dangerous parking by either by using the <u>online reporting</u> function where you can upload pictures or by calling 101 immediately.

Illegal parking

A reminder for all that, according to the Highway Code, it is illegal to park:

- opposite or within **ten metres** of a junction,
- over a dropped kerb,
- on a pedestrian crossing (including the area marked by the zig-zag lines),
- in spaces reserved for Blue Badge holders, residents or motorbikes (unless entitled to do so),
- in marked taxi bays, cycle lanes or on red lines,
- near a school entrance, bus or tram stop, or

We have asked the Parking Enforcement team to make more regular visits to ensure that these rules are being adhered to, and to encourage local residents and parents to work with us in challenging illegal parking by reporting it. If you notice a vehicle parked in any of the above areas, please report it to the local council who may issue the owner with a penalty charge notice. They can also be contacted at park-ing@molevalley.gov.uk /03456 009 009

If you are finding parking a struggle, why not consider using one of our <u>Breakfast Clubs</u> which allow parents to use the school car park to drop off until 8.00am.
