# From Sunday's Gospel...

06.06.22—All children return to school

07.06.22—KS2 District Sports at KGV Playing grounds, Effingham This Sunday, we celebrate the **Feast of The Ascension**. In this week's Gospel, (Luke 24:46-53) we hear the story of Jesus ascending into heaven. We hear that Jesus is seated at the right had of the Father. Traditionally referring to sitting at someone's right hand meant that they had been given a symbol of approval and a place of

honour. When we say Jesus is at the right hand of the Father, we are not speaking of a physical place but of the honour that Jesus is granted because of the Father's love and approval for him. You might like to pray the line from the Nicene Creed together "He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father."



### **Summer is here!**

A reminder please that when children come back to school after half term, we hope that the weather will be hot!

It is important that children stay hydrated, so please make sure your child has a water bottle. This can stay in school and be rinsed out overnight in class.




# **Photography Competition**
