Congratulations



New Sign In App

We have a new signing in and out system at St Peter's. If you are a parent visiting us to help out in school you will be asked to sign in using the new tablet. Parents who are collecting children early from school for medical appointments, will be asked to also use the tablet to sign their children out with the reason why.

From Monday, all children arriving after the gates are locked at 9am will need to sign in at the office using the tablet. The system will then monitor late arrivals and this information will be shared with our Attendance Officer. Please do make every effort to be at school a few minutes before the 9am cut off so that your child is settled in class ready for the day to begin at 9am. As you can see from the table below, even being 5 minutes late soon adds up to a considerable learning loss.
