From Sunday's Gospel...

This coming Sunday we celebrate the **13th Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In this week's Gospel ([Luke 9:51-62](#)), Jesus explains the importance of making commitments to our choices to three people who tell him they want to follow him, but that they still want to do something else as well. Jesus may sound harsh in his response, but he is making an important point that helps us understand what it means to be a mature disciple: to make a commitment is to embrace certain choices and to let go of others. A relationship with Jesus involves some sacrifices but also gives us the best thing we could possibly ask for: life with God. Please try to read the Gospel with your child.



Parking Controls

We have been informed that signage for the new parking controls on Grange Road and surrounding roads agreed by Surrey County Council has been installed.

A single yellow line restriction (no waiting or parking) will operate on **Grange Road and Blades Close** from **Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2pm to 4pm**.
