If your **KS2 (Y3-6)** child <u>DOES NOT</u> usually have school dinners and would like to have a Christmas Dinner please make a payment off £2.60 via ParentPay by Friday 2nd December. If your child usually has school meals then they will automatically have the Christmas Dinner - you do not have to make an extra payment.

Festive Picnics

When the hall is being used for Christmas Dinner, children in the other classes will need a packed lunch, provided by parents please, which will be eaten in class as a 'Festive Picnic'.

- Children in Years R-2 need to bring a packed lunch on Thursday 15th December.
- Children in Years 3-6 need to bring a packed lunch on Wednesday 14th December.

If you are in receipt of means tested Free School Meals or would find it challenging to provide a packed lunch from home on these days, please let us know by Friday 2nd December as we will be able to help.
