### This week in school...

Dear Parents and Children,

We began our week with a special video assembly led by Mrs Walsh, our Family Support Worker and Action for Young Carers to mark Young Carers' Day. A young carer is someone under 18 who helps look after someone in their family who is ill, disabled or misuses drugs or alcohol. There are an estimated 14,000 young carers in Surrey and 30% of the young carers are under the age of 10. At St Peter's we want to make sure that any young carers feel supported. We want them to feel they have someone at school to talk to; they are not alone and have the support of each other. If you think your child might be a young carer please let Mrs Walsh, our Family Support Worker, know.

Children in KS2 enjoyed a live lesson from the Houses of Parliament Education Team on Monday afternoon, learning more about how Parliament works and the system of democracy in the UK.

It was lovely to see so many of you at Parent Consultation evening this week - we hope that you enjoyed looking at your child's work and can see how much progress they have made this year.

Thank you to the wonderful FOSP for running the Mother's Day shop over the last few days. I am sure that all the female carers in your families will enjoy their presents and I hope that you all enjoy the day.

We ended the week with a big splash of green in school, and we wish all our families with Irish connections a very happy St Patrick's Day.

Finally, good luck to all the children taking part in the Cross Country event this afternoon.



Congratulations to Mrs McDonnell who has been appointed as the Headteacher at Send CofE Primary School, in Send, Surrey from September 2023.


Mrs McDonnell has been our Deputy Headteacher for 16 years and the impact that she has had on St Peter's has been immense. She has not
