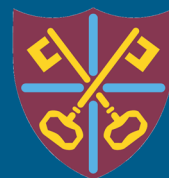

Big Schools' Birdwatch

5th-9th February



Next week St Peter's will be involved in the Big Schools' Birdwatch. This is our chance to contribute some important data to find out how many birds are in our school environment. We will be acting like citizen scientists contributing to one of the largest animal surveys in the World. We have put up bird feeders in readiness to attract birds to our outside areas. Last year the blackbird was the top bird spotted by schools. We will let you know what our data shows this year.

Geography News Book

Each class has their own news book named 'What's happening in the World?'. Each child in turn takes the book home. In Reception they may record where they went to at the weekend, whilst in Year 6 they are encouraged to choose an international news item with a geographical focus that really interests them. The purpose of the book is to help develop the children's geographical skills and to make them appreciate Geography is everywhere, in their everyday lives, on their journeys to school, in the places they live, extending to the world in older years. They then bring the book into school to share with their classmates, often using maps or digimaps to locate associated places.
