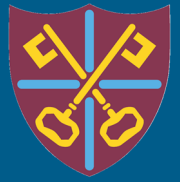

## From Sunday's Gospel...

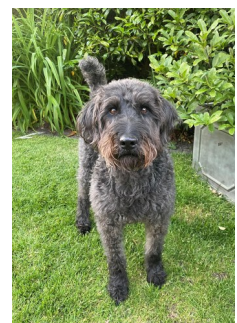
### 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

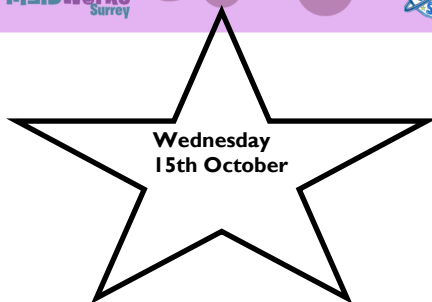
