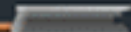
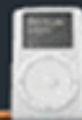

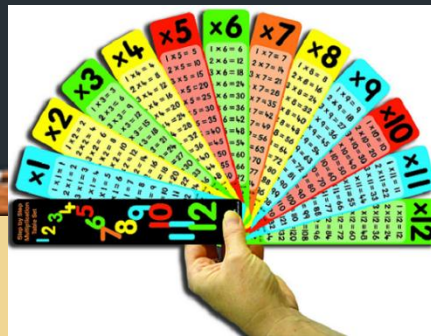
Science topics:

Times tables

- By the end of year 4 your child will need to know their times tables up to the 12x.
- We will be practicing times tables in class every week and every other week will send home times tables to practice via TTR sessions.
- The children will be taking part in a statutory multiplication check in the summer.
- The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided. We would ask you not to mention the check to the children, and when we do the check in summer it will be a very low-key in order for them to not be anxious or stressed.



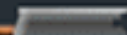
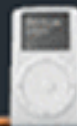
Homework

If they are struggling with the homework they can bring it to us at any point during the week for help.

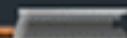
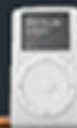


Reading

They should have their reading diary in school every day.

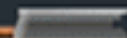
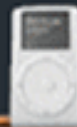


JDO
