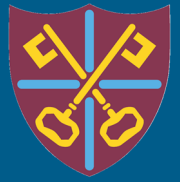

Today we started our Reconciliation sessions for Years 4,5 and 6. Thank you so much to Father Chris for coming to do this for us, and for all his dedication and support.

Posada

A "travelling crib" (or **Posada**) is a popular [Advent tradition](#), inspired by the Mexican "[Las Posadas](#)", where small figures of Mary, Joseph, and sometimes a donkey travel from home to home or church to church, staying overnight with different families who host them before Christmas. Each host sets up a mini-nativity scene, prays, shares the Christmas story, and then passes the figures to the next person, creating a community journey symbolizing Mary and Joseph's search for lodging.

We are delighted to be continuing with this tradition here at St Peter's. Each class is welcoming the Posada into their classroom and each weekend one of our families will welcome it into their home too.



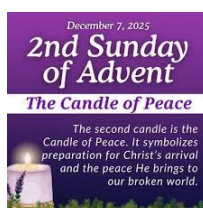
