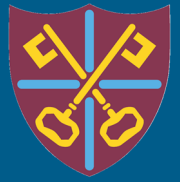

From Sunday's Gospel...

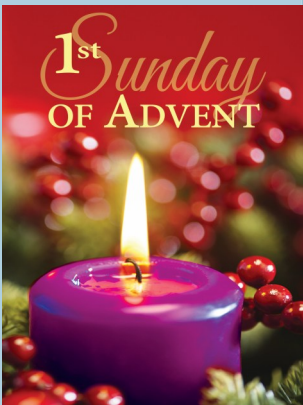
First Sunday of Advent

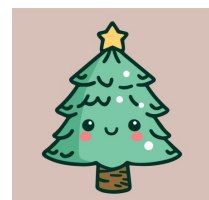

Helen Maguire MP came to school to give Izzy her prize and have a photo taken with her.

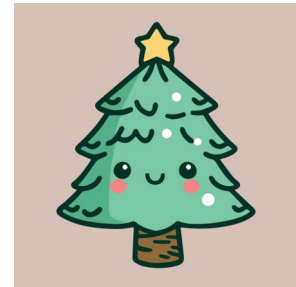




St Peter's Post Box opens Monday 1st December

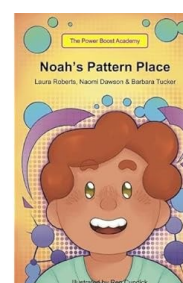
