Art-Sculpture and 3D: Interactive installation. We will be studying installation art, space and scale before creating our own 3D art.

Would you like to live in a desert? We will locate deserts around the world; names and describe the physical features and the human activity.

History Topic Question

What can the census tell us about local areas? We will learn about Victorian children and jobs and compare them with census records in 1911, 1921 through to today.

Guided Reading - Each day, we will be focusing on a different reading domain skill. Our class read this term will be Holes by Louis Sachar.

Writing - This half term, we will be writing diary, playscripts and dialogue with speech punctuation. After half term, we will be writing a recount as a trip review, writing balanced argument as well as writing fiction using figurative language. We will be focusing on Year 5 grammar skills such as relative clauses, modal verbs and devices to build cohesion (adverbials of time), parenthesis (brackets, dashes and commas) and commas to clarify meaning.

Computing- E-safety, Programming BBC Microbits, & vector graphics and Stop motion animation.

Music - Composition to represent the festival of colour (Holi), Looping and remixing and Musical theatre.

Latin Chapter 9 - A soldier's life - prepositions of place and position linked to prefixes in English.
