Hopefully the sun will chase the rain away for cross country later—wishing everyone the very best of luck!

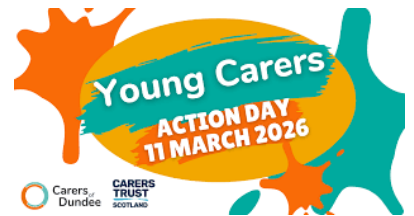

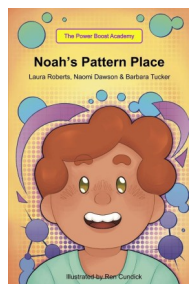


Author Visit

Canon Jonathan will serve in this capacity until the Holy Father appoints our next bishop.

We assure him of our prayers as he takes up this responsibility, and we continue to pray for our diocese during this period of transition.

During the afternoon there will be:

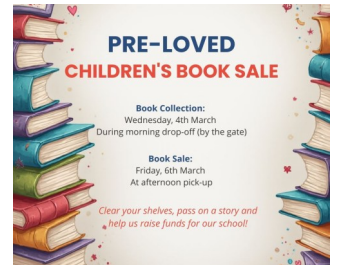
- Several bingo rounds with prizes
