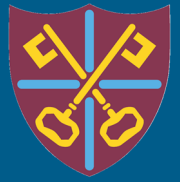

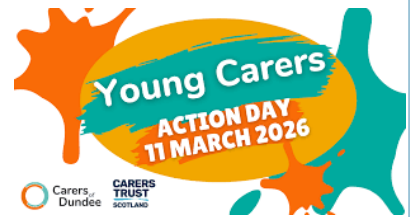
Young Carers Action Day

Thank you to Mrs Walsh who organised the event.

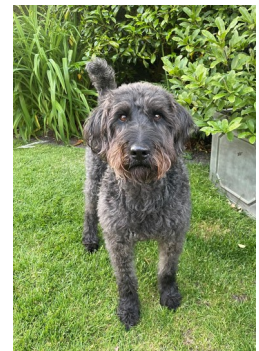


From Sunday's Gospel...
