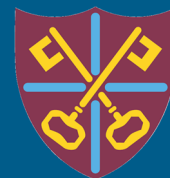

Canon Jonathan will serve in this capacity until the Holy Father appoints our next bishop.

We assure him of our prayers as he takes up this responsibility, and we continue to pray for our diocese during this period of transition.

We're excited to be launching our very first Spring Bingo — a fun, relaxed family event open to parents and children.

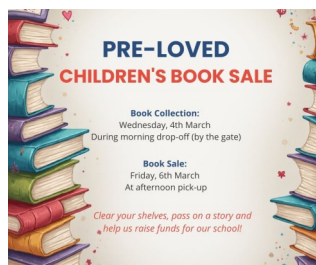
The event will begin straight after school at 3.30pm, making it easy for families to stay and join in the fun.
